

## STAGE TWO INSTRUCTIONS

1. Remove the vacuum slide from the C.V carb. Remove the stock needle & spacers, noting order of assembly (Fig A).

2. Install the Dynojet needle on groove #3, using all stock spacers (Fig. A). Install the Dynojet washers above the e-clip.

3. Remove the air intake snorkel from the air box. With the stock exhaust and K&N filter drill the stock main jet in the C.V carb with the drill (DD #51) provided. With an after market header or slip-on with high flowing baffle drill the C.V carb main jet with the drill (DD #50) provided.

4. Locate the Fuel Mixture screw on the bottom of the Slide Carb. Carefully turn mixture screw clockwise until seated, then back out 2-1/2 turns.
